

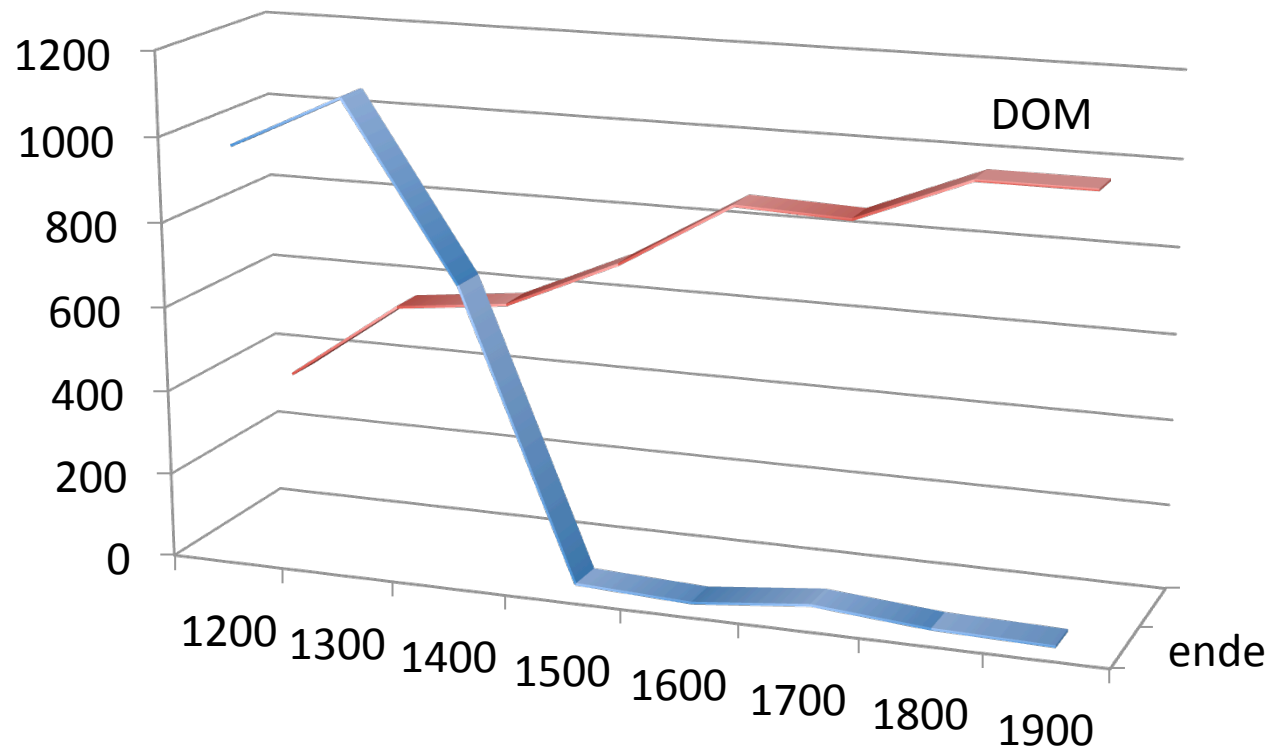

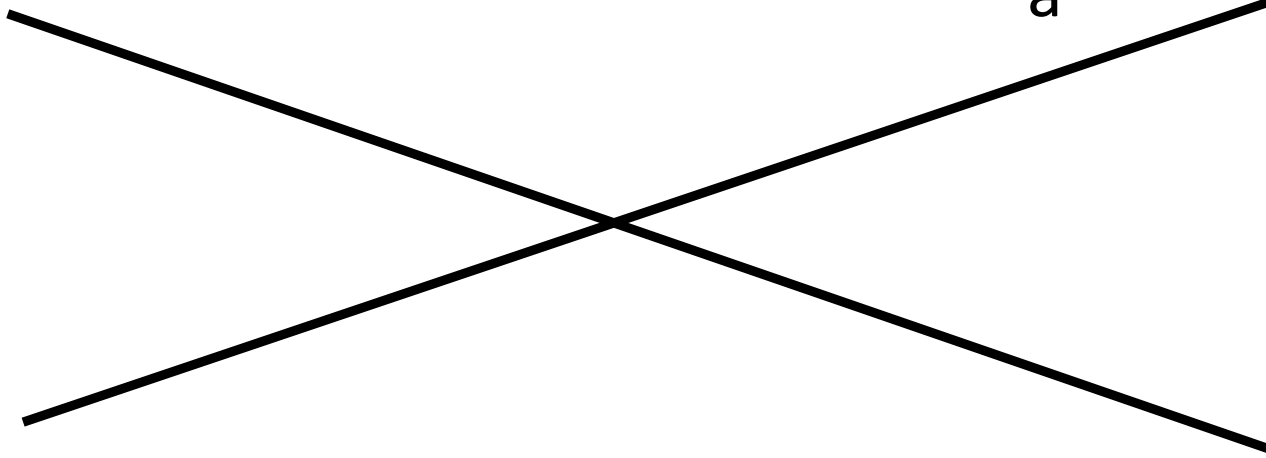

nouns: **N** GN

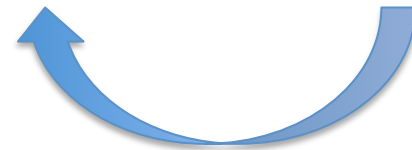
objects: MC **N**
